

Concessions Weeknights Procedures

Please wash hands before starting work. Any food handling please wear gloves

Make coffee, 4 large spoonful's of coffee- Brew

Fill 2 pots just with hot water from coffee maker, for hot chocolate. Use red handle spout

Hotdogs:

Put a couple of cups of water in bottom of warmer.

We start with 8. If run out, do 4 more at a time.

Have to be 160 degrees before putting in warmer in foil pan.

DO NOT make any hotdogs after 7:45, If needed - microwave any that are ordered after for 30s.

Do not give condiments without asking, give them out. Saves on waste

Popcorn:

Throw 1 bag in at a time, have all 3 switches on.

When popcorn slows down TURN off first 2 switches on the left. Leave last switch on.

Do NOT make popcorn after 7:45 pm, Push what is left. We have at times wasted a lot of popcorn.

Do not make more than 1 bag at a time.

Nachos:

Fill plastic tray with chips/cheese. Push the bottom button on cheese dispenser and hold until full.

Pretzels:

Microwave frozen large pretzels for 50 seconds, 40 seconds for small

Ask if customer wants cheese. If customer wants salt spray with water, dip in Tupperware of salt

Root beer / Orange floats:

3 scoops of ice cream in red solo cups to a Half can of pop, spoon and straw.

Any downtime

Make injury ice packs. Plastic bags are in brown drawers, ice in freezer.

Disinfect all counters, microwave (inside & outside), wipe down freezer, refrigerator.

Sweep / mop at end of night.

8:15- clean hotdog grill with plain water. Use cloths in brown cabinet/drawers, **DO NOT USE** any chemicals. Turn roller on and remove grease. Put dirty towels in sink. Turn roller off

At the end of shift

Clean popcorn machine by scooping out any old popcorn, kernels wipe inside down with clean paper towel.

Restock any products/ beverages

*****ALWAYS *****

Put older beverages on left side of refrigerator or behind, do not mix them around. Have to watch expiration dates.

Thursdays- take garbage out.
